A) Suzanne's Riding School

You can start horse-riding at any age. Choose private or group lessons any weekday between 9.00 a.m. and 8.30 p.m. You can ride across farmland and open country. You will need a riding hat.

B) Glenmorie Golf Club

After a three-hour introduction with a professional golfer, you can join this golf club. The course is situated in a beautiful countryside and is open all week. There are regular social evenings on Saturday in the club bar. You will need your own golf equipment.

C) Avon Watersports Club

We offer speedboat racing and water-skiing. A beginners' course consists of ten 20-minute lessons. You must

be able to swim. The club is in the city centre and is open daily from 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m., with lessons all through the day.

D) Lackford Sailing Club

In our Young Sailor's Course you'll learn how to sail safely. The course also covers sailing theory and first aid. Have fun with other club members afterwards in the clubroom. (Tuesdays 6.00 p.m. – 8.00 p.m.).

E) Adonis Centre

Our experienced instructors offer onemonth courses in deep-sea diving. There are two evening lessons a week, in which you will learn to breathe underwater and use the equipment safely. You need a swimming costume and towel.
