She/He will ask you questions about your family (family members, likes and dislikes ...) and about school (your interests, your likes and dislikes ...) Please answer her/his questions as well as you can.

**Then** you will take the role of the journalist. You should find out as much as you can about your partner's

- Free time activities
  - free time?
  - hobbies and interests?
  - time with friends or family?
  - perfect weekend?
  - conflicts with her/his parents about free time activities?
- Plans for the future
  - what school next year?
  - job she/he would like to do one day?
  - dreams for the future?
