# UNTERLAGE FÜR DIE LEHRKRAFT



INTERLOCUTOR:

- **You are going to talk to your partner about young people and going out. One of you will play the role of a parent, the other the role of a teenager. Act out the role that is given to you on your prompt card.**

**[NAME A], here are some points to talk about with [NAME B]. You will have to start the discussion.**

Give prompt card A to student A.

- **[NAME B], here are some points to talk about. Your partner will start the discussion.**

Give prompt card B to student B.

- **You now have 3 minutes to look at your prompt cards and to think about what you want to say.**

**You can use the arguments on the prompt card if you want to. You can also think of your own arguments.**

- 🕒 **Allow the students 3 minutes to get acquainted with the materials and to collect their thoughts.**

- **Now let's have the discussion. Both of you should talk as much as possible.**



## GOING OUT

### PROMPT CARD A


You are 14, and your parents are very strict; you are not allowed to go out in the evening at all. You want more freedom and so you decide to discuss your situation with your mother/father.

**You open the discussion.**

**You can use the following arguments if you want to:**

- 14 – old enough to go out
- friends: may go out till midnight
- lose friends
- school: no problems
- pay with pocket money
- no dangers
- try to find a compromise

## GOING OUT

### PROMPT CARD B

You are a parent of a 14-year-old; you are very strict, and you do not allow going out in the evening. Your child wants to discuss the situation with you.

**STUDENT A opens the discussion.**

**You can use the following arguments if you want to:**

- not before 16
- see friends during day/at school
- good friends near home/going out not important
- tired at school → bad grades
- going out: very expensive
- together with friends at home – no dangers
- try to find a compromise
