- 🗨️ **[NAME], now tell me about your room. What does it look like? Do you like it or would you like to change it? Why? Why not? How is your room different from the room in the picture?**

**You have got 2 minutes to tell me about it.**

PROMPTS (if necessary):

- **What do you like / not like about it?**
- **What would you like to change?**
- **Do you think your mother or father will allow you to change your room?**
- **Have you changed your room before?**
- **What did you change? Why?**
- **Would you like to have a room like the one in the picture?**
